**COPY CUT PASTE:
CONTEMPORARY COLLAGE**

This group show at the new John Buckley space, tucked behind an unmarked blue door in a Prahran back street, spans mediums, approaches and generations. Works by John Nixon and Gareth Sansom – whose work is a fantastic mash-up of typically unhinged drawn forms, a photographic self-portrait and a ripped-open box of Cialis – feature prominently, as do mid-career artists such as Nick Mangan and Jennifer Goodman. But it's young artist Marc Savoia who steals the show. His dynamic, intermittently organic and geometric reappropriations of classic film and performance stills, architecture and shards of colour are graphically bold and packed with allegorical, gender-bending detail.
